



Missouri's law only provides a consequence if the child left alone in the vehicle causes an injury or death. We are still working with the state of Missouri to enact a proactive preventative law similar to our model law.

MISSOURI STATE LAW SECTION 568.052

Creates the crime of leaving a child unattended in a motor vehicle. The crime is a Class A misdemeanor if an unattended child 10 years of age or less causes the motor vehicle to injure another person, and a C felony if the injury is fatal. This portion of the act is identical to HB1146.
